### Dickinson Catholic Schools - MIDA Bonds

We authorized the Dickinson Catholic Schools to issue MIDA bonds for the construction of their new facilities. These bonds allow the Dickinson Catholic Schools to finance their new addition at a very attractive interest rate. This project is a great addition to our area.

## 2023 IT Service Contract

We approved our 2023 contract with Consolidated Communications for our IT service. Consolidated does our IT troubleshooting work, maintains our county email system, and provides guidance and service for our technology equipment.

#### **Roads & Bridges**

We received an update from Highlands Engineering, Northern Plains Engineering, and KLJ Engineering on a number of road and bridge projects that we are trying to get done in 2023 and future years. As you can imagine, the costs to do road and bridge projects have exploded in the last couple of years, and we want to get our priority projects lined up and completed as soon as possible.

#### **Courthouse HVAC Improvement Project**

We authorized allowing the Courthouse HVAC improvement project to go bids. A lot of the HVAC system in the original building which was built in 1936 is original and is in dire need of an upgrade. We hope to open those bids at our February meeting.
